"Nominees should hold a management position in the credit industry or be a team representing the credit function of an organization and be able to demonstrate the following experience, qualities and attributes:".

1. Nominees should be able to demonstrate he/she or the members of the team have made a significant contribution to the credit and collection industry and be able to represent it's organization and or employer by being able to show the following:
  - a. Clear efforts or achievements demonstrated in maintaining the highest standards of honesty, integrity and creditability in dealings;
  - b. Active participation in credit and collection events in Hong Kong, China or other region;
  - c. Participation, organization and/or facilitation of educational event and or enhancing employer involvement in prospering the credit and collection industry;
2. Nominees should be able to demonstrate their ability and skills in Management and Operation of a credit and collection department by demonstrating the following skills, experience and achievements:
  - a. Ability to effectively communicate with members of credit and collection team within the organization to enhance and successfully manage the credit and collection management function;
  - b. Excellent human resources skills;
  - c. Achieved improving result on credit risk controlling issues within the organization;
  - d. Ability to demonstrate a variation in resolving long-term objectives within the credit and collection functions;
  - e. Enhancement productivities and securities through automation projects;
  - f. Other projects and ideas established to enhance credit management capabilities
3. Nominees should be able to show their contribution to the enhancement of customer service by showing the following abilities:
  - a. Enhancement of communication and interaction with internal and external customers;
  - b. Creation of Value Added Services within the Credit and Collection Function;

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**Guidelines**

1. Nominations are opened to member or non-member or a team who is currently practitioner(s) in the credit & collection management field. Nominator has to be a current member of the Association.
2. Presiding Executive Councilors in the Executive Council for the current term are not eligible for nomination (inclusive of being a team member of a nominated team) for the Award. All nominations are held in confidence. Submitted documents and nomination form are non-returnable and are subject to verification & authentication by the HKCCMA's Annual Award Committee.
3. Team Award and Past Individual Award Recipients only eligible to be re-nominated as a team member of a nominated team. All Past Award recipients are not eligible for re-nomination for Individual Award.
